He is a Visiting Professor at King's College, London, and a Fellow of the Society of Professional Economists. He graduated from Durham University, and did his postgraduate work at the University of Amsterdam. He was awarded an honorary doctorate in Economics by Nottingham Trent University in 2012. He was made a CBE in 2019.
